Champion : Frank Lambert - Lotus 6

1172 FORMULA

The aggregate result of the second full season's 1172 Formula racing shows a convincing lead for Lambert, who, on a basis of 5 points for a win, has gained a total of 29 out of 50 in his Lotus by virtue of three wins and two seconds in six races, as well as having run in the winning 1172 Formula race in the Three Hour Relay.

The runner-up this year was MacDowel, with another Lotus, with 21 points, while third place is a tie between Dave Small's D.H.S.II and Marriott's Buckler 90.

This year has seen some very fine racing amongst the 1172 Formula fields in that in no case has there been anything approaching a runaway win, the several Lotus, the D.H.S. and the Marriott Buckler 90 being very evenly matched. The fields, however, are still too small and most 1172 races have been combined, either with 750 Formula events or some limited capacity sports car event which has detracted from the spectacle.

1172 FORMULA

The detailed results of one 1172 Formula race, only just received, have some effect on the aggregate results as published under the above heading in last month's Bulletin, though fortunately, they do not affect the first two places.

The following are entitled to receive one more point as a result of competing at the A.M.O.C. meeting than they were credited with last month: W.G.Marriott, E. Lewis, J.Abbott, A.P.Staniforth, M.H.Clare.

This gives W.G.Marriott a total of 16 and a point lead in third position over D.H.Small who thus becomes fourth instead of sharing third place. M.H.Clare now shares 8th place (7 points) with J.Corfield and R.Walshaw. J.Abbott now has 6 points and shares 11th place with Dennis Parker, while A.P.Staniforth now totals 3 and Mrs Scott-Moncrieff 2.

Unfortunately, also, the initials of Mr F.V.Lambert, who achieved the highest aggregate were misquoted and we should like to emphasise that he is indeed the Lambert concerned (as will, of course, already be clear to those who follow Formula events).

Champion : Michael McDowell Lotus Mk 9

CHAPMAN CUP

The probable destination of the Chapman Cup for the 1955 season has been pretty clear from the first race where Michael MacDowell, in his Lotus IX exhibited a clear superiority over the rest of the field. To have achieved a total of 89 points out of a total of 90 is nevertheless a most remarkable performance and one deserving of our heartiest congratulations. Incidentally, although MacDowell's has been the only Lotus IX in 1172 Formula racing, it has the simplest Mark IX specification, having Ford wheels and rear axle and none of the elaborations such as disc brakes, wire wheels or de Dion axle.

The only car to beat MacDowell was Jim Whitehouse with his Arden, who only appeared three times, but achieved a win, a second and a third, proving that this driver and car can be just as successful with an 1172 engine as they have been in the past with a 750.

Runner-up in the Chapman Cup competition is Ken Laverton, who has four second places and two third to include in his total of 59 points.

Third this year is Frank Lambert, present holder of the Chapman Cup (its first year of existence) as a result of his performance in 1172 Formula events last year.

The popularity of 1172 Formula racing continues to increase and, in spite of MacDowell's superiority, excellent racing has been seen in this class. Moreover, the turn-out of the entry as regards mechanical fitness and appearance has always been a credit to the Club, which is more than could always be said of the 750 Formula cars.

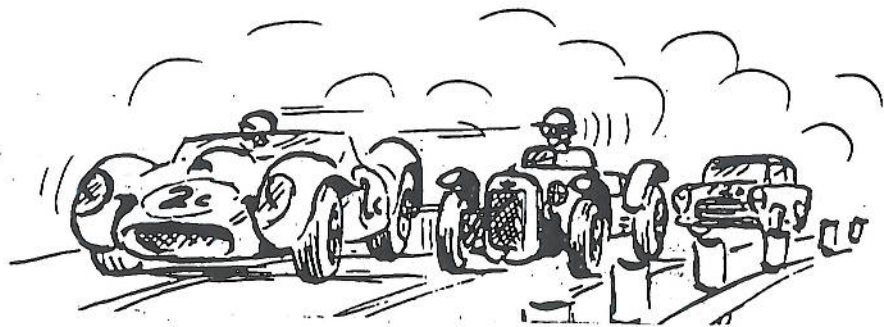

The above table shows that the Championship is still wide open and as exciting as it can possibly be. If Bryan Small wins the final race at Brands Hatch on November 27th, then he takes the Championship, even if John Lancaster places second. If, on the other hand, John Lancaster wins this final race, then he will take the Championship even if Bryan Small places second.

Peter Loakman will inevitably be the highest placed first season driver and so will, presumably, take the Mike Eyre Cup.

Since this was written it has been found that the Brands race is combined with the Up to 1000 c.c. Sports Racing Car event and under the present system the points will not count. However, Barry Simons will give us our own race if the 1000 c.c. class is poorly subscribed. The exact position won't be known for a few weeks unfortunately.

O.H.V. engines were admitted to the Formula for the first time in the 1966 season.

John Lancaster won the Championship using a 1000 cc O.H.V unit.

Formula 1200—Seasonal Survey by Brian Cocks

The 1969 season has been a very full and successful one for Formula 1200. With nineteen Championship events, from which the best ten count, no one could complain of a lack of racing, or variety, as the events covered eight of the major circuits. Fifty-one competitors entered the Championship and all but nine used the O.H.V. engine. National Formula 1200 Champion and Chapman Cup winner is Geoff Bremner, who,

for the first time for many years, scored a brilliantly consistent maximum number of points. This performance is a great credit to Bremner's preparation and development of his U2 as well as his fast driving. In his third year in the Formula, Bremner's achievement proves the true value of 1200 as the real amateur's low cost racing formula. The U2 has cost him under £500 all told, he had had a very full season's racing and his lap times are only a few seconds

away from Formula Ford records, at a third of the cost. The first half of the season saw exceedingly close racing. With such press comments as "another epic dice", Geoff Bremner and early Championship leader Brian Cocks fought out the first eleven rounds in their U2's. Foolish driving with the "flu" at Snetterton, Cocl crashed heavily, writing off the U2 and h
